The system ( [www.radioreference.com/apps/db/?sid=4403](http://www.radioreference.com/apps/db/?sid=4403) ) is already in the HP-1. You should not have to re-enter it, just select it from the database. Note that it is not a Motorola system, it is APCO 25 Phase I. If you entered it as Motorola, it won't scan.
