You should probably contact Radio Reference (www.radioreference.com) if you believe that the data is incorrect. This is where the Sentinel software gets its data. A quick check of the site does show that all the Air Traffic Control freqs are FM (www.radioreference.com/apps/db/?aid=3277).

Assuming that you have these freqs in a favorites list, you can edit the info through the Sentinel software. Click on the Edit Favorites icon; select the particular favorites list which has the freqs you need to edit; click on the item in the left hand column which will contain the freqs for editing; observe the column labeled "Modulation," and click on it; this should bring a drop-down menu with the mods; select AM. Viola! Remember to select save under the file menu before leaving the edit screen.
