I monitor the road, dispatch, and wayside or maintenance frequencies and hear traffic quite often. The CSX dispatcher is, I think, located in Jacksonville, FL and can communicate on using different antennae. On my BC-346XT I programmed the in use for Maryland that I have learned are used on the Metropolitan subdivision.

For my work location in Virginia, I added some CSX frequencies.
