I just left Vegas (was there for CES). You didn't mention that some Arizona is also loaded. This is due to LV's proximity to both states (the state is loaded if you are within about 30 miles of the border). What I did (and recommend for such situations) is to relax with HP-1 in front of you for a while, and liberally use the "AVOID" function on the systems / departments / channels you don't really care about. Then, after you haven't needed to avoid anything for a while, create a favorites list and tell it to &guot; Use Current Channels. &guot; This will bring in all the stuff you have not avoided from the current selection.
