After entering my zip code, I selected the various services I wanted to monitor including "Railroad". I was informed that there are no railroads in my zip code area even when the area to be included is expanded to 30 miles. This is technically true. However, there are "repeaters" for each of the three railroads(all less than 30 miles away)that now come in very clearly on my other scanners. I feel certain that this scanner would easily transmit these frequencies as well if I could get them entered into the scanner.
