Same problem here with the trunked system names disappearing. I have had the problem all along however, beginning when I first got the HP-1 and purchased ArcPatrol.

Another problem that I've had all along is with avoids not being saved when I save a Favorite file. When I open the file the next time avoids have disappeared and need to be clicked on again.

I have had both problems on 3 different computers with WinXP 64 bit, WinXP 32 bit, and Vista. It gets to be really annoying.
