If you look at RR, Home Patrol is using Dec #9820 for Hardin County Dispatch 1 which is a depreciated analog system. The county converted to digital years ago. The number that should be used for Dec is

21712 for Hardin County Dispatch 1 and so on in the system being it is now digital, not analog. adioreference.com/apps/db/?sid=766
